Possession of a valid State of Oregon medical license at the time of appointment. Eligibility for appointment to the medical staff at local hospitals. Drug Enforcement Agency number will be required. NPI number at the time of appointment.

Summary of Essential Duties:

Medically evaluates patients and assesses their medical status in the clinic. Determines, establishes and administers an overall treatment program for patients and chronically ill clients. Determines the clinical need for medications, and prescribes medications as part of a treatment program. Provides information, consultation and assistance to other health care professionals. Discusses case management and techniques with health care professionals. Provides appropriate medical records documentation on all patients in accordance with policy.

Knowledge of/Ability to:

Diagnose, treat and control diseases and physical injuries in a clinically sensitive manner for underserved populations. Effectively gather, evaluate, and convey sensitive and confidential information. Work with professional independence and use initiative and judgment in performing medical diagnostic and treatment services for the patient population. Prepare concise, accurate and effective medical reports, recommendations, policies and procedures. Establish and maintain cooperative work relationships with patients, staff, peer groups, and varied agency and institutional representatives.
